DSNY (Dept. of Sanitation)	<p>During the day shift today 6 spreaders ,3 Flow & Dumps, 3 Haulsters, 3 FEL's and 31 Plows totaling 46 pieces of snow fighting equipment deployed.</p> <p>The night shift will deploy 6 spreaders ,3 Flow & Dumps, 3 Haulsters, 3 FEL's and 30 Plows totaling 45 pieces of snow fighting equipment.</p> <p>Trash Pick up is suspended</p>	<p>The Department has more than 693 spreaders and 1499 plows deployed.</p> <p>The equipment is operating throughout the five boroughs in each of the City's 59 Sanitation Districts. Additionally, we have 131 pieces of equipment from other city agencies, including DOT, DEP, and Parks.</p>
DOT	<p>DOT deployed 470 personnel working in conjunction with DSNY to clear snow.</p> <p>Clearing pedestrian overpasses and bus shelters</p> <p>CityBike Share is up and running.</p>	<p>SAME</p>
MTA	<p>Subways and buses are operating with no shut-downs currently – but with weather related delays in both directions.</p> <p><i>Brooklyn, local, limited, select and express buses are running with delays in both directions because of inclement weather conditions.</i></p> <p><i>Planned Detour</i></p> <p><i>B24 - Northbound buses may experience delays due to construction on Greenpoint Av at West St</i></p>	<p>MTA operating under Cold Weather Plan–</p> <p>Express tracks are running locally</p> <p>4500 MTA personnel deployed</p> <p>2000 buses on the streets with chains</p> <p>Station crews present maintaining stations to assist with accumulations</p> <p>Buses making all local stops / commuter rails about 30-45-minute delays</p> <p>1200 paratransit vehicles are operating with snow chains</p>

DPR (Parks Dept.)	<p>Assisting DSNY for the next 3 shifts with 39-44 plows</p> <p>1300 Maintenance & operations staff removing snow around parks</p> <p>Salt spreaders and snow blowers deployed</p> <p>Working with Dept. of Homeless Services (DHS) with Code Blue – checking on known “homeless spots”</p> <p>Emergency Operations monitoring trees throughout for potential issues</p>	SAME

DHS/DSS (Dept., of Homeless Services / Social Services)	<p>Code Blue issued city-wide. Working alongside of NYPD and Parks Dept.</p> <p>Drop in centers are open 24 hours – all shelters. If no room is available at a local shelter – transportation can be provided to an available shelter site.</p> <p>Job Centers are open. Missed appointments are not penalized. No notices issued.</p> <p>Dot – ass470 personnel working in conjunction with dsny</p> <p>Clearing pedestrian overpasses and bus shelters citybike is up and running</p>	SAME
